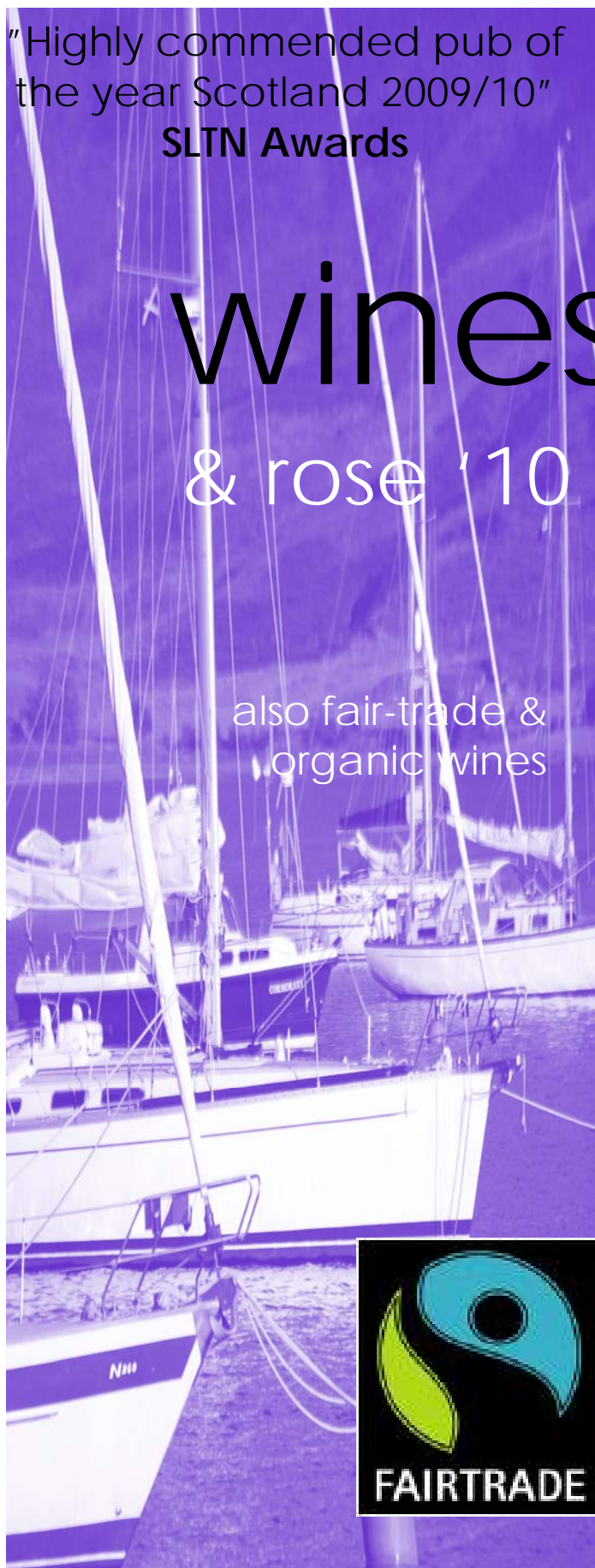

1. (2) **Ochre Mountain Fairtrade Sauvignon Blanc** (Chile) 
Fresh and citrus on the nose with clean acidity and a good intro to fair-trade easy drinking with fresh clean dry flavours **16.95**
2. (1) **Ruben Hall Sauvignon Blanc 2008** (New Zealand)
Fresh and zesty with ripe gooseberry fruit and a crisp dry finish, superb on its own or enjoyed with our fresh Creel, Line and Hand dived Seafood Platters **20.95**
3. (1) **Las Ondas Sauvignon Blanc 08** (Chile) **NEW ARRIVAL for 2010**
A fresh clean and spritzy dry white wine - no shortage of lively fruit, grapefruit and green apple hints. Goes well with smoked salmon, risottos and seabass **15.95**
4. (2) **Boomerang Bay, Chardonnay, Grant Burge 2007 / 08** (South East Australia)
Clean balanced & crisp with light citrus apple character. A popular choice with our mussel crockpot dishes and hand dived Loch Nevis Scallops **17.95**
5. (2) **Pinot Grigio Ponte di Piave, Veneto 2008** (Italy)
Very light, dry, good structure, revealing just a hint of green fruit, also good with risottos, cheese dishes and simple summer Drinking. A popular Pinot Grigio **19.75**
6. (2) **Stellar Running Duck Fairtrade Chenin/Sauvignon Blanc 08 Organic NEW ARRIVAL for 2010** (S.Africa) A good all round refreshing white combining the grassiness of sauvignon with ripe guava fruit of chenin  **18.50**

7. (C) **Ochre Mountain Cabernet Sauvignon/Merlot Fairtrade** (Chile) Rounded and smooth in flavour. A pronounced blackcurrant fruit and a firm favourite on our wine menu  **16.95**
8. (D) **Stellar Running Duck Fairtrade Shiraz 2008/09 Organic** (Western Cape, South Africa)  Medium bodied red, soft, spicy, plenty of berry fruit and a hint of white pepper on the finish. Also great on its own **18.50**
9. (C) **Boomerang Bay Shiraz 2007/08** (South East Australia)
From one of Australia's most respected wine makers, this Shiraz offers soft tannins with juicy black fruit flavours and a velvety texture - warm and peppery. A good partner for our game stews, steaks & venison dishes **17.50**
10. (D) **Bellingham Pinotage 2008/09** (South African)
A wine with intense bramble aroma, complemented by a full soft, round palate rich and spicy. Enjoy with Lochaber Hill lamb, Aberdeen angus steaks, Knoydart venison and game dishes. A gem of a wine **21.95**
11. (C) **Paternina Banda Crianza Azul Rioja 2005** (Spain)
A traditional Rioja with soft redcurrant and vanilla oak both on the nose and the palate. This wine will have spent a minimum of six months in oak **22.95**
12. (B) **La Baume Merlot 2008** (France) **NEW ARRIVAL for 2010**
A simple berry with round plum aromas followed by a mid- bodied palate. A classic old world wine and new arrival to our wine list by customer recommendation **19.50**
13. (5) **Millstream Rose** (South Africa) **NEW ARRIVAL for 2010**
Pale vibrant pink rose, clean and fruity, in particular strawberry. Light bodied—a friendly glugger. **15.75**
